Civil Discourse and Difficult Decisions is a national initiative of the federal courts that brings high school and college students into federal courthouses for legal proceedings that stem from situations in which law-abiding young people can find themselves. These court hearings are realistic simulations that showcase jury deliberations in which all students and learning styles participate in civil discourse. Proceedings are conducted in courtrooms presided over by federal judges who are assisted by volunteer attorneys, including members of local chapters of the Federal and Alabama Bar Associations. Although student attorneys argue the case, student jurors and their deliberations are at the centerpiece of the courtroom event.
